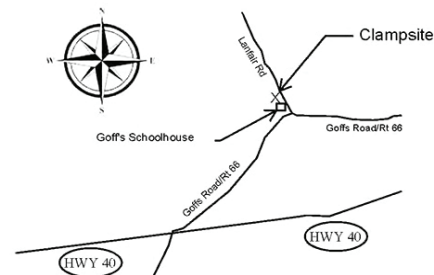

FROM HWY15 - TAKE INTERSTATE 40 EAST TOWARDS NEEDLES 107 MILES TO EXHIT 107 RT 66/GOFFS ROAD TOWARDS FENNER. TAKE THIS ROAD 10.7 MILES, AND TURN NORTH ON LANFAIR RD. CAMPSITE IS ON THE WEST SIDE OF ROAD LESS THAN 1/2 MILE FROM RT 66.

DIRECTIONS FROM EAST:

FROM INTERSTATE 40, EXIT 107/RT 66 AND GO NORTH EAST ON RT 66 FOR 10.7 MILES, TURN NORTH ON LANFAIR RD, AND PROCEED LESS THAN 1/2 MILE TO CLAMPSITE ON WEST SIDE OF ROAD.
